The Purpose of this Course

The purpose of Truth Church University is twofold:

1) Foundational Doctrine

Helps you deepen your faith by learning and applying Biblical principles to your life.

Provides opportunity to ask questions and set-up a time with an instructor for a one-on-one Bible Study.

2) Ministry Integration

Provides understanding of the various opportunities available to serve the kingdom of God locally, regionally, and even globally.

Helps you develop and utilize your talents in service to the kingdom of God. There are many training opportunities we provide so you can be equipped for service.

Assessment test helps you understand your God given strengths.

Helps you fulfill the crucial mission of reaching your friends and family with the truth.



Lesson 1: Truth Church History & Vision

Truth Church University, referred to hereafter as TCU, is designed to give you an overview of our church by sharing with you who we are and what we believe. This first lesson will serve as a basic introduction to Truth Church, as we share our history, leadership, vision, and ministries.

QUESTION: Who are we?

We are a church that ministers to every individual and to the entire family. We seek to identify with Jesus Christ by living in a way that is pleasing to Him through obedience to His Word. We are apostolic in our doctrine and our identity by seeking to teach the apostles' doctrine and seeking to emulate the apostles' lifestyle as revealed in the New Testament. We are Pentecostal in experience by identifying with the birth of the church on the Day of Pentecost through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. We believe that every believer should exhibit the fruit of the Spirit and operate in the gifts of the Spirit.

Jesus told his followers to make disciples throughout all the world. Our world begins in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, and we want to help as many people as possible within our community and region come to know Jesus Christ through His Word and through His Spirit.

QUESTION: Where did Truth Church start and who started it?

Truth Tabernacle, now named Truth Church, was started on July 1st, 1967, by Rev. Roy Moss.

While holding a one-week spring revival in Sperry for Pastor Preston Branum in May 1967, Roy Moss had a vision on Saturday night/Sunday morning in which he saw himself preaching in a Baptist church in Bartlesville. The vision included several scenes of great moves of the Spirit of God and people receiving the Holy Ghost.

On July 1, 1967, Brother Moss, who was assistant to Brother Barry King, relocated from Oklahoma City to Bartlesville, bringing all his worldly possessions in a 1965 Volkswagen bug and all his financial resources -- \$297.00. He rented former servant's quarters at 210 East Fourteenth Street for \$40.00 per month, bills paid. While trying to schedule Bible studies and/or find a place to hold services, he attended the First Baptist Church and arranged to teach the *Search for Truth* Bible study to the young adult class of the Training Union on Sunday evenings.

After purchasing a former Freewill Baptist Church building at 1038 South Hickory, he opened the windows and preached to an empty building, hoping that people sitting on their porches would hear. Several did later attend. Neighborhood children told their parents, "There is a crazy man down the street. He is preaching and there is no one else in the building."

In September 1967, Charles and Geraldine Townsley, and their four children, were transferred by Phillips Petroleum from Borger, Texas, to Bartlesville. This fine family became the core of the church that would emerge in this city of more than 35,000.

In January 1969, Roy Moss wed Barbara Stafford of Morris, Oklahoma.

It was roughly two years before the first convert was filled with the Holy Ghost. When the Mosses took her home from church that night, she was still talking in tongues. It was the next day before she could speak English again.

The first eighteen years were spent in the facility on South Hickory until a congregation could be gathered and a new church could be built at 4100 Northeast Nebraska Street. It took six years to build this facility from groundbreaking to laying the carpet. They built mostly as funds were available, and funds began to multiply in a series of miraculous provisions. This facility was finished debt free.

Several preachers received their call while in the Bartlesville church. Among them are Larry Booker, Dale Stevens, Joe Findley, Kevin Erickson, and Rob Yohnk.

After 46 years of service, Rev. Moss resigned from the church on May 26, 2013. Rev. Brian Fuller became pastor on July 1, 2013, forty-six years to the day after Rev. Moss had arrived in Bartlesville.

Pastor Brian Fuller has continued the vision of growth and God has continually added to the church.

In 2016 and 2017, the church undertook a major remodel inside and out. The saints of God gave of their time and resources to see the house of God renovated, and in the summer of 2017, we celebrated 50 years as a church! What a time of rejoicing that was.

In 2020, a parcel of ground that was connected to the church, over 2 acres, was given to the church and opened the door for expansion. We are ever grateful for Mr. & Mrs. Gene Brown for their kind contribution. In 2021, we started purchasing equipment for our 50' x 50' enclosed playground for our children. In January of 2022, we had a 30' x 50' metal barn built on the property and completed the playground. After almost 3 years of work on the property, playground, and ponds, we had a dedication and celebration in July of 2023.

In 2022, the church launched three other ministries out of Truth Church of Bartlesville: Truth Church Pawhuska, Truth Church Dewey, and Truth Church en Español. In November 2023, Truth Church Pawhuska was able to purchase a building to have church at 1118 Lynn Road, Pawhuska.

Today, we are blessed with seven licensed ministers and their families, a wonderful board of directors that help with major decisions of the church, a large volunteer staff that works diligently for God's people, and amazing saints that deeply love God.

Through the years, the church has seen many miracles, signs, wonders, and provisions from the Lord. The church is steadily growing in number and in the knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ.

 - We offer personal home Bible studies taught by a member of our church family. A home Bible study provides far more in-depth study of Scripture and the opportunity for discussion related to the Scripture.
 - We also offer Purpose Institute, a classroom setting with experienced instructors, to study the Word of God at a collegiate level.
 - Specialized training to help people develop in their relationship with God.
- Fellowship: there are fellowship opportunities for various age groups, men, women, children, youth, and young adults.
- Discipleship Classes: Truth University 101 & 201.
